EMIS practice booking instructions

All EMIS practices have been asked to submit up to three usernames and smartcards numbers to enable access to the Locala – Calderdale Supporting Families unit.

You will need SystmOne installed on your PC and your smartcard inserted. It is ok if your practice role for your EMIS unit has already been chosen for your smartcard.

Start SystmOne and 'Log on' to the Calderdale Supporting Families Unit.

- Click search on the top left of the screen and search for your patient by Firstname; Lastname; date
 of birth or NHS number.
- 2. Double check the details and double-click on the correct patient.
- 3. Select the appointment menu item at the top of the screen and choose 'Appointment Ledger'



4. Carefully select the correct location and check that the patient's parents are clear about the site where they should be attending. You can use the 'Site' menu on the left to limit your search to one location.




- 5. Right click on an appropriate time slot and choose 'Book Appointment'.
- 6. Complete the details and save the appointment.
- 7. Then save the record.

SystmOne Booking Instructions

The service is being hosted on the Locala Calderdale Supporting Families unit and appointments can be made through 'Remote Booking', as is used for Extended Access.

To make the appointment from your SystmOne practice unit:

Go to Appointments/Remote Booking



2. Click the drop-down Show Rotas For option and select - Calderdale Supporting Families



3. Rotas available to you will be shown in black type. If you have the Show fully booked rotas option ticked unavailable rotas will be shown in grey type.




4. You will be able to book into any site but please make sure that the parent/guardian understands where they will be taking their baby.
